"THE SUFFERING SERVANT"

PASSAGE: Is. 52:13-53:12

Discuss

Question: How do those who are guilty receive God's grace?

It is only through the Suffering Servant, Jesus, who is our:

1. perfect substitute and sacrifice (53:1-9)
Jesus was not the kind of Messiah everyone was waiting for. What does this mean for us?
 - Look at vs. 4-6. What emotions should this fuel in us? Instead, what does it actually often fuel in us?
 - What do these verses have to say to those of us who tend to feel we have it all together?
 - The innocence of Jesus often seems like an abstract concept, but why should we continue to place it before our eyes?
2. victorious Savior and King (52:13-15, 53:10-12)
 - Jesus bore the sin of many. Name several ways this should affect our attitude about our sin.
 - As we struggle with the present times, how does the future portion of this passage give us hope?

Praise Jesus for his enormous grace in being crushed for our iniquities!

Confess that though he has brought us peace, we often refuse to rest in it.

Thank God that Jesus will be exalted and that we will one day see him as he is.

Ask God for us to deepen in our trust in the finished work of Christ on our behalf.
