## "GOD'S POWER DISPLAYED"

**Big Idea:** When we grasp God's character and how he works in this world, we can follow his leading with complete confidence in his perfect plan and promises.

DATE: February 26, 2017

SPEAKER: Jared/Frank

SERIES: The Life of Moses

PASSAGE: Exodus 6:28-7:13

## Discuss

1. The paralysis of a misunderstood mission (vv.6:28-30)  
What does Moses not understand about himself? about Pharaoh? about God?  
Moses questions his actions based upon a wrong view of what will happen. Where do you see this in your life?
2. The importance of grasping God's character and his ways (vv. 7:1-5)  
What is encouraging for us about how God handles Moses' doubts?  
How are Moses and Pharaoh similar? Whom do you tend to be more like? Why?  
Exodus talks often about God hardening Pharaoh's heart and Pharaoh hardening his own heart. How are we to hold these things together?
3. The experience of seeing God's power as he keeps his promises (vv. 7:6-13)  
What changes in verse 6? How does that affect our understanding of trust and obedience?  
In what ways have you seen God keep his promises this last year in your life? What caused you to doubt them?

## Pray

Praise God that he rescues his people regardless of what it might feel like to his people.

Confess the ways that we let our self-loathing and self-sufficiency get in the way of obeying God.

Thank God for specific promises he has kept to you and to your group.

Ask God to cause us to speak the truth about God and to walk in obedience regardless of our circumstances.
