PASSAGE: Exodus 17:8-16

Discuss

As we journey as God's people, we must:

1. expect struggle (v.8)
Considering the events after the crossing of the Red Sea, what is God trying to teach them?
What particular aspect of your life is filled with struggle that causes you to doubt God?
2. embrace provision (vv.9-13)
Name several ways God provides in this text.
Moses needed help with arms. How does God provide you with help in this church?
3. express praise (vv.14-16)
Moses wants this to be remembered so he builds an altar.
How can worship help us remember specific instances of God's provision?
Moses was worshipping out of allegiance to God. We often misuse worship. How do we misuse it, and how can we as a group combat our misuse?

Pray

Praise the Lord as a group for the specific prayer requests you have seen him answer this year.

Confess the ways we selfishly use worship to simply make us feel better.

Ask God to give us a more full worldview where we expect to struggle and suffer.

Thank God that he gives us people to help hold us up when we are too tired.
