"FREE TO FEAST"

Big Idea: Because we have been set free by God's grace, we feast on God's grace both now and in eternity.

PASSAGE: Exodus 12:31-51

Discuss

I. Freedom: We are set free from slavery by God's grace as God turns...(vv.31-42)

- A. his raging rival into his delivering instrument (31-32)
- B. the place of pain into the place of provision (33-36)
- C. an exiled few into his world changing nation (37-41)
 1. What is significant about who summons whom in verse 31?
 2. How do we see the theme of God reversing rivals play out in the life of Jesus?
 3. Where is a place of pain for you, and how have you seen God provide in the midst of it?
 4. Why did God make Israel wait 430 years, and what does that mean for you?
 5. Throughout the rest of the Old Testament, where do we see the Israelites honor and dishonor the Lord for generations to come?

II. Feast: We are set down to feast on God's grace. (vv.43-51)

1. In what aspect of life are you most prone to forget the provision of God?
2. In what way is obedience in your life connected to the rescue of God?

Confess your current doubts about whether God is really with you.

Thank God for the tangible reminders he sends us of his love.

Ask him to strengthen our faith and obedience out of trust in his rescue.
