“DELIVERED AND DEFENDED”

Big Idea: God delivers his people from all that would enslave them and defends them from all that would destroy them.

DATE: March 26, 2017

SPEAKER: Joe/Len

SERIES: The Life of Moses

PASSAGE: Exodus 13:17-14:31

Discuss

1. God delivers his people from all that would enslave them.

- Is the exodus really about God delivering his people out of Egypt, or is there a greater deliverance at work?
- How are people typically enslaved in today's culture? Is this any different for believers?

Can we at LMPC be enslaved to good things, and in what ways does God reveal our enslavement?

2. God defends his people from all that would destroy them.

- Knowing that Christians do often suffer and have even faced imprisonment and death, how should we understand God's defense of his people? How does Matthew 10:28 speak to this?
- In what ways does this story point you to the work of Jesus?

There are many stories of Christians who have suffered greatly, but whose faith shone even brighter in the midst of their suffering. Can you think of examples in your own life where you have seen God preserving his people in the midst of their suffering? See 2 Corinthians 12:9.

Pray

Praise God that he delivered us from all that would enslave us.

Confess your fears and doubts that God is truly fighting for you.

Thank God for defending us from ultimate destruction.

Ask him to strengthen our faith and obedience as we trust in his rescue.
