Story Point: In this passage of Scripture, Jesus warned that one day the destruction of Jerusalem would come through God's judgment because the people had turned away from him. Jesus warned his followers that when the armies began to surround Jerusalem, they needed to escape to the mountains. Many of the Christians in Jerusalem listened to Jesus' words and escaped God's judgment upon Jerusalem. Jesus also told his disciples about the return of the Son of Man. While many will fear the signs on the earth that will come before Jesus returns, Jesus tells his followers not to fear but live with hope and confidence. Why? Because for the believer these signs mean our redemption is drawing near.
