The Art of iPhone Photography- Kelley Hoagland and Beth Wingfield

Instead of taking quick snapshots, learn to create intentional, thoughtful photographs on your iPhone. Beth and Kelley will share simple photography basics and editing tips that will elevate your images.

Beginning Needlepoint- Clare Kent

Learn the foundational tent stitch, the essential stitch for any needlepoint canvas. In this beginner-friendly class, we will work on a small cross-themed canvas, perfect for learning technique while creating something meaningful. All supplies are included. As you stitch, you will also learn how needlepoint can become a quiet, restorative practice, helping you rest your mind while creating with your hands.

Ceramics: Hand Building Wall-Hanging Vases- Stephanie Martin

In this studio, we will explore clay through hand building vases that will affix to your wall. I will guide you through the process of designing and bringing your vase to life. Once dried, we will finish these vases by using various surface design techniques by either transfer or painting with underglaze. Come prepared to get your hands (and maybe your clothing) dirty!

Collage- Katy Holloran

In this studio, we are going to create a collage on a card! We will use magazines to source our images/words. If you have a few magazines sitting around your house, feel free to bring them! My hope is that everyone will leave with a new skill/passion to create cards for those they love.

Floral Design- Bronwen Wiggins and Kakhi Wakefield

This studio class will combine mountain-foraging ideas with foundational floral techniques. We will have foraged seasonal branches, evergreens, and winter textures, then blend our gathered treasures with a curated selection of blooms to create a sculptural winter arrangement. We'll also share a hand-tied bouquet demonstration, offering techniques you can use year-round.

Jewelry-Making: Ellie Hildebrand

We will be making bandana and silk charm necklaces. Attendees will be invited to connect their creations of jewelry to their own hearts and stories in a playful and imaginative way.

Liturgical Prayer: Hannah Lutz

In this studio, we will examine both corporate and private prayer using Scripture, movement, and spiritual formation practices that have been part of the church for centuries. You will have the opportunity to think and talk through how these practices shape us as believers, to experience some of them together, and to write out prayers for yourself and/or your family.

Mindful Movement- Hollee Brock

The body is the creative tool in this workshop! Come try a joyful, barefoot movement practice that supports creativity and connection with God, self and others. Kindle the joy of being alive through dance, breath and presence as movement opens vision, energy and meaning, encouraging new things.

The Ministry of the Table: Creative Tablescaping- Rachel Allred

This workshop guides you through creating beautiful, functional tablescapes for any occasion using pieces you already have at home, while also offering tips for finding special treasures that bring polish or

a touch of whimsy. You'll explore how to layer textures, mix colors and patterns, make the most of your tableware, and incorporate simple, stunning florals—all in an interactive, relaxed setting designed to spark your creativity and build your confidence as a host.

Sourdough Basics- Lori May

Learn the benefits of baking with sourdough, how to feed and maintain your own sourdough starter (provided), and how to make, shape, and bake a loaf of your own at home.
